UNCOVERING YOUR SEPTIC TANK FOR INSPECTION WHEN A SEPTIC RECORD IS NOT FOUND

New Procedures when applying for an Existing System Evaluation, that requires approval from the Building Department:

(Loan Closings/Adoption/Foster Parent Evaluations **not** required... **unless we do not have a record on file**, see #2 if record is not found)

- 1. Septic System Record/Permit IS ON FILE?
 - A. Receive a copy from our office for your records
 - B. 4 corners of the septic must be marked prior to inspection
 - C. Any additions to the home or property must be staked/marked prior to inspection
- 2. Uncovering your tank for inspection, when a Record <u>IS NOT</u> <u>FOUND</u> see drawing below.
 - A. Uncover the Entire top of tank...Do NOT remove the lid
 - B. Uncover 2 feet down the outlet side of the tank (see drawing below)
 - C. Carefully uncover the pipe going towards the drain field (about a 2 ft. section is sufficient)
