1. ON-SITE SEWAGE MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS	
Permits for Installation of Systems:	
Residential including mobile homes:	
1000 square feet* or less	\$150
1001 to 2000 square feet*	\$250
2001 to 3000 square feet*	\$350
3001 to 4000 square feet*	\$450
4001 and up	\$550
A floor plan is required for houses, mobile homes and commercial buildings. *FORMULA FOR CALCULATING RESIDENTIAL SQUARE FEET IS: WIDTH x LENGTH x NUMBER OF FLOORS= TOTAL SQUARE FEET. Includes basements (finished and unfinished) and garages.

1 to 10 lots:	\$200 Review fee plus \$60 per lot
11 to 20 lots:	\$300 Review fee plus \$60 per lot
More than 20 lots:	\$400 Review fee plus \$60 per lot
Changes or resubdivision of recorded lots	\$60 per lot
REPAIRS AND ADDITIONS Permits	
Residential	\$100

Central (no per unit fee)	\$250

REINSPECTIONS (due to contractor or property owner negligence)	\$100
This fee will not be imposed routinely. Only in cases of clear disregard for our time.	
MONITORING FEE (alternative and experimental systems--per inspection)	\$50

8. BOARD OF HEALTH POLICY ON FEE COLLECTIONS:	
Government agencies and charitable organizations will not be charged fees for services. Delinquent fees will be charged an additional \$25 per month not paid. Fees for environmental health services may be waived or reduced when in the opinion of the environmental health county manager or district director collection may prove counter to the goals of public health or is a financial hardship.
